## **RESOLUTION NO. 93-027**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIS HONOR, THE CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH PRIVATE INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS AND DESIGNATING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF NAGA DEVELOPMENT OFFICE FOR LIVELIHOOD, EMPLOYMENT, COOPERATIVE AND MANPOWER (DOLECOM) AS THEIR JOB PLACEMENT ARM UNDER CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND THE SAME MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BE SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD: -**

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Naga has established an employment placement office known as the Development Office for Livelihood Employment, Cooperative and Manpower (DOLECOM) aimed at providing job placement opportunities for its constituents in response to the need to solve unemployment in the locality;

**WHEREAS**, it was deemed that this program can be most effective if it operates in partnership with private business and industries;

**WHEREAS**, various industrial and commercial establishments have pledged to support this job placement program by designating the city's DOLECOM as their job placement arm;

**WHEREAS**, this partnership can only be actualized thru a Memorandum of Agreement executed by and between the City Government of Naga and these industrial and commercial establishments.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. J. Agapito Tria II, duly seconded by Hon. Rodolfo Z. Fortuno;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize His Honor, the City Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with private industrial and commercial establishments and designating the City Government of Naga Development Office for Livelihood, Employment, Cooperatives and Manpower (DOLECOM) as their job placement arm under the following terms and conditions:

1. An amount equivalent to 12% of the monthly salary/wage of the placed or hired applicant for the first six (6) months shall be remitted by the hiring company or establishment to the City Government to cover the additional fund allocation for the operation of DOLECOM;
2. Others that may be determined by both parties to be equally beneficial.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that said Memorandum of Agreement be subject to the ratification of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.:

**LET COPIES** of this resolution be furnished His Honor, the City Mayor, and all concerned private industrial and commercial establishments for their appropriate action; the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Development Office for Livelihood, Employment, Cooperative and Manpower (DOLECOM) for their information and guidance.
