RESOLUTION NO. 96-163

RESOLUTION CREATING THE NAGA CITY TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD DEVELOPMENT CENTER (NAGA CITY TLDC): -

WHEREAS, with the opening of the economy to world trade, the need to transform local producers into world class entrepreneurs has become more urgent;

WHEREAS, to attain world competitiveness, these local producers require support from the city government over and above the usual menu of infrastructure and social services;

WHEREAS, assistance is particularly needed by budding entrepreneurs who are far from their markets, are way behind in technology, with poor access to credit, and thus are ill-equipped to come out with world-class products;

WHEREAS, responding to this need, the Naga City Government is initiating the establishment of a Technology and Livelihood Development Center (TLDC) as one of its development strategies;

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint and collective motion of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga present;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to create the NAGA CITY TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD DEVELOPMENT CENTER under the following purposes and objectives, powers and functions, and composition:

PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose and objectives of the Center are:

- (a) To serve as the City Government's service provider for the institutionalization of entrepreneurship by, for, and among the marginalized sector of society;
- (b) To identify, source, process, store, utilize, commercialize, promote, popularize and disseminate appropriate technologies which will enhance urban and rural socio-economic and livelihood development;
- (c) To assist and support the livelihood development program of the government by providing the necessary technical and financial support to eligible individuals and small to medium-scale enterprises;
- (d) To promote the use of appropriate indigenous resources and technologies among individuals, households, communities and industries for improved production and service facilities;

- (e) To serve as referral and information center to link technology users to appropriate technology and technology experts, and to provide assistance on government technology;
- (f) To provide technology and livelihood information, feedback to serve as inputs in the formulation of policies;
- (g) To provide linkages with local as well as foreign institutions and international bodies concerning the identification/sourcing, processing/storage, utilization/commercialization, promotion/dissemination and funding of technologies;
- (h) To promote the application of information technology in development programs of government and private entities;
- (i) To establish a data communications system with linkage with information networks both foreign and local.

PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES

To fulfill and accomplish its purposes and objectives, the Center shall have the following powers and functions:

- (a) To provide technical, financial, managerial, marketing and extension support to individuals or entities using new, improved or existing technologies;
- (b) To identify, establish and maintain a roster of technology resource experts from the government and private sectors and utilize such experts to assist technology users in undertaking all the phases of projects utilizing appropriate technologies;
- (c) To identify and obtain the necessary project financing or grants from the government and private financial institutions, including overseas, regional and international sources;
- (d) To conduct trainings, seminars, clinics, demonstrations and tours and produce technology films, video and publication and undertake such other related activities for the dissemination and promotion of technology;
- (e) To identify, source, search, process, disseminate and store the information disseminated as would affect social and economic planning and development, and to subscribe to, acquire, process and disseminate textual, statistical and graphic data and information needed by decision-makers and other users;
- (f) To source funds in the form of loans or grants from any local or foreign institution, government or private, to finance its program and projects and to package the funding thereof;

COMPOSITION

The DOLECOM, a division under the Office of the City Mayor, is hereby designated to compose and shall now be known and referred to as the Naga City TLDC.

The governing body of the Naga City TLDC shall be composed of the following:

City Mayor	-	as Chairperson
DOLECOM Chief	-	as TLDC Administrator and Vice-Chairperson
Project Implementation Committee Members of DOLECOM	-	as Members
ABC President	-	as Member

Secretariat services shall be provided by the existing personnel of the DOLECOM who are hereby transferred to the Naga City TLDC.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Naga City TLDC all contracts and agreements which it may enter into and execute and to accomplish and deliver any and all documents relative to such contracts and agreements.

LET COPIES of this resolution be furnished His Honor, the City Mayor for his concurrence, the DOLECOM Chief for his information and to all other concerned agencies/persons.
