Notes:

1. This Price Watch is a public information assistance primarily aimed at providing choices for consumers that will help him/her make an informed decision when buying petroleum products in Naga City. The local government does not have the power to regulate prices of petroleum products, as the energy industry was deregulated through a law of national application. Thus, we only provide information to support free choice among consumers.
2. It is also hoped that this Price Watch will abet friendly business competition among petrol stations, for the benefit of the consumers. It is probable, therefore, that price adjustment of product/s may occur at anytime of the day as a direct result of this competition.
3. The petrol stations are clustered based on location and route for easy reference and guidance of consumers.
4. The petroleum products per company may have different names, but basically the products are: premium, unleaded, regular, diesel and kerosene. LPGs are not yet included in this Price Watch. Two hyphens (--) means the product is "not sold" in the petrol station.
5. The Diesel discounted rate for PUJs is voluntary on the part of petrol stations giving it. There is no law that requires it.
6. Updating of this Price Watch Report is on a weekly basis, OR when there is a reported price adjustment in one or more petrol stations either due to local business competition or national imposition.
